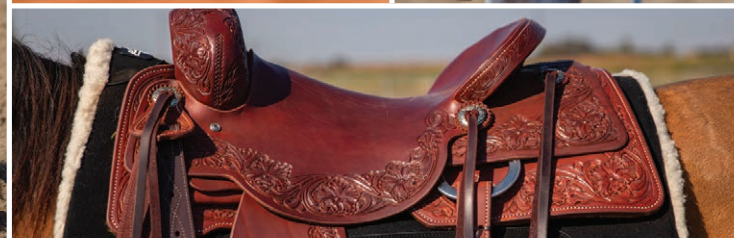

EVENT RULES & INFORMATION

NATIONAL POINTS RACE DIVISIONS

The top 20 contestants from their home state in each rating division enters the World Finals with 40 to 2 points, respectively (20 to 1 for the Masters & Youth & Western Heritage divisions). Points will then be added from the following classes to determine the Top 10 World Champions in each listed rating category.

The Top 20 from each division in each state are eligible for year-end awards. If a member's rating moves up one number during the season (June 15, 2025–June 13, 2026), the rider will finish the season in his/her original division. If a member is moved up two ratings, s/he will compete in the division applicable for the rating below the new rating. If a member is moved down, s/he will be eligible to compete in the new division. This ruling applies to all rating changes made after the annual, season-end rating reviews.

At the World Finals, for classes not completed before Finals Night on Saturday, points will be applied based on rider standings going into the final round. Saturday night's results will not be used to determine prizes.

Youth points will be applied after completion of the Youth #8 class.

Western Heritage year-end division awards will be presented at the completion of each WH class. Points will be applied after each class completion.

CHALLENGE OF THE CHAMPIONS

1. Back Tag Ceremony banquet hosted Saturday, June 6, at 7:00 pm.
2. The top 5 money-earners in their division this season will get the opportunity to face off with the other division qualifiers in a "Challenge of the Champions" Round Robin. The contender in each division with the most cows sorted in the least time at the conclusion of the Round Robin, will be crowned the division "Champion of Champions" and win \$1,000! Each of the top 5 qualifiers will be awarded a Cinch shirt, Felt Back Tag, and a Challenge of the Champions Qualifier award. The back tags will be numbered 1 through 20, with back tag number 1 being awarded to the overall highest money-earner in the contest.
3. This season began after the 2025 World Finals and concludes on May 25, 2026.

LUCKY DUCK BRACKET SORT

1. The lucky duck bracket sort is limited to 32 teams. Teams with the first option to enter are sorting teams that were 1 hole out of the money. The rest are drawn from nominated contestants for good deeds or bad luck.
2. The bracket sort will have 5 rounds. Round 1 will have 32 teams, Round 2 is 16 teams, Round 3 is 8 teams, Round 4 is 4 teams, and Round 5 is the final 2 teams. Rounds 4 and 5 will run during Finals Night on Saturday.
3. Bracket Sort Rules: This class is a #18 Handicap. Two teams will start behind the line. The announcer will say "Cattle Are ready, cattle number" When the number is called, time starts. The team with the higher score when time expires for both teams will advance to the next round. If a team receives a no-time, time is stopped and the other team automatically advances.
4. If a re-ride is required, both teams will re-ride immediately.
5. This is a head-to-head race, not an average. Winners of the race advance to the next round until two teams remain. Prizes for the top 2 teams.
6. This is a 100% Payback class and pays 2 places.

STATE EXTRAVAGANZA RULES

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Must be qualified to ride at the World Finals
2. Must be one of the top 3 riders in the national points race in your respective state and rating division

A State can have up to 3 teams. To determine teams, the highest placing riders from each eligible division will represent Team A. Second highest placing riders will represent Team B. Third highest placing riders will represent Team C.

State Extravaganza Teams are made up from the following divisions.

1. BEGINNER/ROOKIE/GRADUATED ROOKIE
2. NOVICE/GRADUATED NOVICE
3. AMATEUR/GRADUATED AMATEUR
4. OPEN
5. MASTERS

Tie-Breaker Rule for Eligibility

1. # of Shows attended
2. Most points earned at any one show in the season

Masters Riders can qualify to compete on 2 different teams if:

- They are in the Top 3 Position in their state in the Master and rating division
- If a Masters rider is tied for 1st or 2nd, they exchange positions with the person below them in the Masters division.
- If they tied for 3rd, the rider will exchange places above them in the Masters division.

1. A team will consist of 5 riders who pick their teams.
2. The Division will be an All-Level Handicap.
3. If a high-point member does not attend, the next highest point member who attends can ride.
4. If no member qualifies or attends in a rating category, then the highest attending member in the next rating category down is eligible.
5. If a Masters does not qualify or attend, any youth attending from that state can substitute.
6. If a state doesn't have enough attending members for a five-person team, they can combine with other states in the same situation.
7. Entry fees are \$75/entry with a required 2-Ride limit.
8. RSNC Trophy Saddles will be awarded to the winning teams.
9. Awards will also be given to the 2nd- and 3rd-place state team.
10. First objective is to win 1st place out of your state's teams in the first round. No state can have 2 teams in the final round.
11. The top 3 state teams with the most cattle sorted in the fastest over-all time in the State Extravaganzas will advance to the finals.
12. The team members of the top three states will all ride again with the same partners as before with a clean slate (three states equaling 15 teams to the finals).

PRO FUTURITY CALCUTTA

*Calcutta for fastest team in the final round. Payback is 80/20 with 20% going to the added money for the #18 Rated Youth class. The remaining 80% is split 80 buyer/20 rider. Pays 1 spot.

FUTURITY RULES

Classes Offered

Pro Futurity

- #18 HC with #6 rider floor (contestants can ride up)
- Both horses must be registered horses that are 4 & Under

Non Pro Futurity

- #10 Handicap (5 cap on riders)
- Ranch Hand Class
- Futurity horse must sort

1. 5-ride limit per rider. No futurity horse can be ridden twice in the same futurity.
2. Contestants must be qualified to ride in the Futurity (5 shows).
3. Added money is paid to the entire pot. Contestants must have 100 rides to be eligible for the Cinch Bonus Money.
4. All paperwork and entries must be submitted to the entry office no later than 9:00 am Sunday. If a horse is entered after 9:00am a \$50 late fee per horse will be applied, no exceptions. RSNC office reserves the right to not accept entries after 9:00am on Sunday.

CINCH RSNC DRESS CODE

All contestants at a Cinch RSNC sanctioned show must wear Western attire: a Western hat is optional, but a collared western button-down shirt and boots are required. Tank tops, tee shirts, polo shirts and ball caps will not be allowed. The first dress code violation by any member will be result in a warning. Each violation after will result in a "no time" for that ride.

MEMBERSHIP

A current Cinch RSNC membership is required to ride at RSNC events and must be purchased prior to class. RSNC memberships are NON-REFUNDABLE and NON-TRANSFERABLE. The Cinch RSNC season runs July 1 through June 30. Silver Cinch RSNC Memberships for members 70 years and older are free. Memberships can be purchased on site, online or by calling the office. 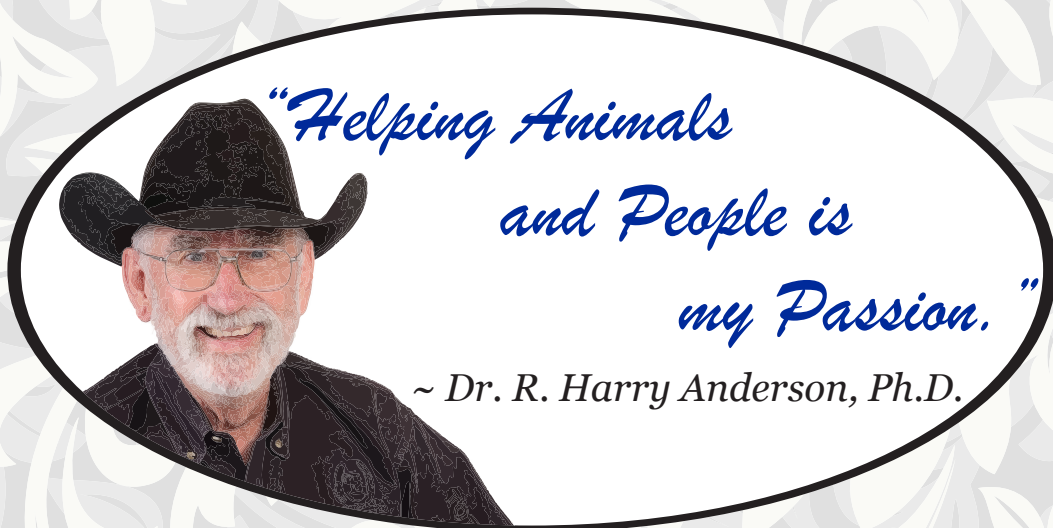
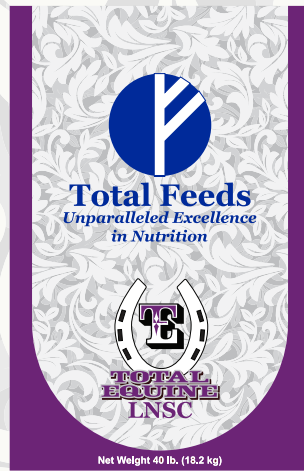
WORLD FINALS QUALIFICATIONS

1. A rider must attend 5 sanctioned shows from June 15, 2025 through June 1, 2026.
2. A rider must ride 5 times in any class/classes for it to count as 1 show.
3. To ride for the added Cinch Bonus Money, a contestant must have 100 rides on the season. Cinch Bonus Money will be paid out to Top 3 qualified teams (unless noted otherwise). If only one team member qualifies, then the qualified member receives the Cinch Bonus Money won by the team. If neither member qualifies, the added money goes to the next team until 3 places are paid.
4. All first-year members are qualified to compete in the World Finals but must make 100 rides to be eligible for the Cinch Bonus Money.
